

# EXPLORING THE IMPACT OF AI ON JOB DESIGN AND YOUR PEOPLE

ICBE and Kemmy Business School UL are part of a European Research Consortium on a project called AI4Labour. 'Reshaping labour force participation with Artificial Intelligence - AI4LABOUR' aims to identify industry tasks that will become obsolete with the introduction of AI and to predict the new task and skill requirements that will emerge. This will identify key changes in task/skill composition, the emergence of new tasks within jobs, skill gaps, and skill redundancies. Knowing the composition of specific jobs into the future is a key input to workforce planning, talent acquisition, talent development and upskilling/reskilling interventions in organisations.

As part of this project ICBE, with Kemmy Business School UL, is extending an invitation to our workshop on 21st June so you can learn more and consider partnering with us on this data gathering towards end of '23 and into 2024.
